GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

These rules should be observed at all times

- All students are required to remain in the compound during the short break times and between classes.
- If classes are missed, a written note should be sent by a Parent/Guardian.

- 7. Students caught defacing or damaging school property will be required to pay for the damages.
- No chewing of gum, no wearing of hats / caps. Regular jackets are allowed.. No hoodies. No correction fluid, dividers, compasses, sharp objects of any kind (including knives).

 ALL Students are expected to dress sensibly and appropriately for the school environment.

NO: Shorts, sleeveless vests, ripped jeans.

FOR GIRLS ADDITIONALLY:

NO: leggings, tights, short/tight skirts, crop tops, sleeveless tops, transparent clothing.
